DLM Forum Members Meeting - Riga - 16-17th June 2015

Information Governance – Opportunities for Harmonisation of Understanding, Approaches and Activities

Members of the DLM Forum Foundation meet for a two-day members' meeting twice a year in spring and autumn. Meetings are traditionally hosted by the country that holds the EU presidency.

The DLM Forum Foundation is now calling for the submission of proposals for papers to be presented at the spring Members' Meeting that will be held in Riga, Latvia on 16–17th June 2015.

'Information governance' means different things to different people. The meeting will address opportunities to harmonise our understanding, approaches and activities in the broad field of information governance. Proposals should be related to one or more of the following topics:

- Information governance and standards across the world
- Information governance and privacy legislation differences between continents
- Use of risk management for information governance
- Information and records management best practice and techniques
- Connection between records management systems and digital preservation systems
- Pre-ingest, ingest, preservation and access interoperability and e-archiving
- Re-use of public sector information implementation of the 'PSI Directive' in archival practice
- Use of MoReq2010 exchange of experience
- European Archival Records and Knowledge Preservation (E-ARK) achievements so far and next steps

Members and non-member professionals are invited to contribute.

Submission of papers

Proposals of papers submitted to the DLM Forum should consist of an abstract (max. 400 words).

- Proposals must be in English.
- Submissions must include the name(s) and short CV(s) of the author(s) with current organization and role, full address(es) including an e-mail address.
- Each submission will be examined on the basis of its clarity, quality and adherence to the main topics of the meeting.
- The DLM Forum will notify all submitters on the result of the selection.

Evaluation

DLM Forum will evaluate proposals and select the speakers in cooperation with the local organisation committee and E-ARK project leaders. The Scientific Committee convened for the meeting consists of representatives of the archives of the European Union member states and representatives of information governance in public and private sector.

15 th April	Notification on the result of selection will be given to all applicants.
11 th June	The speakers will have to provide their powerpoint presentation.
16/17 th June	Papers will be presented in 20 minute sessions in English.
