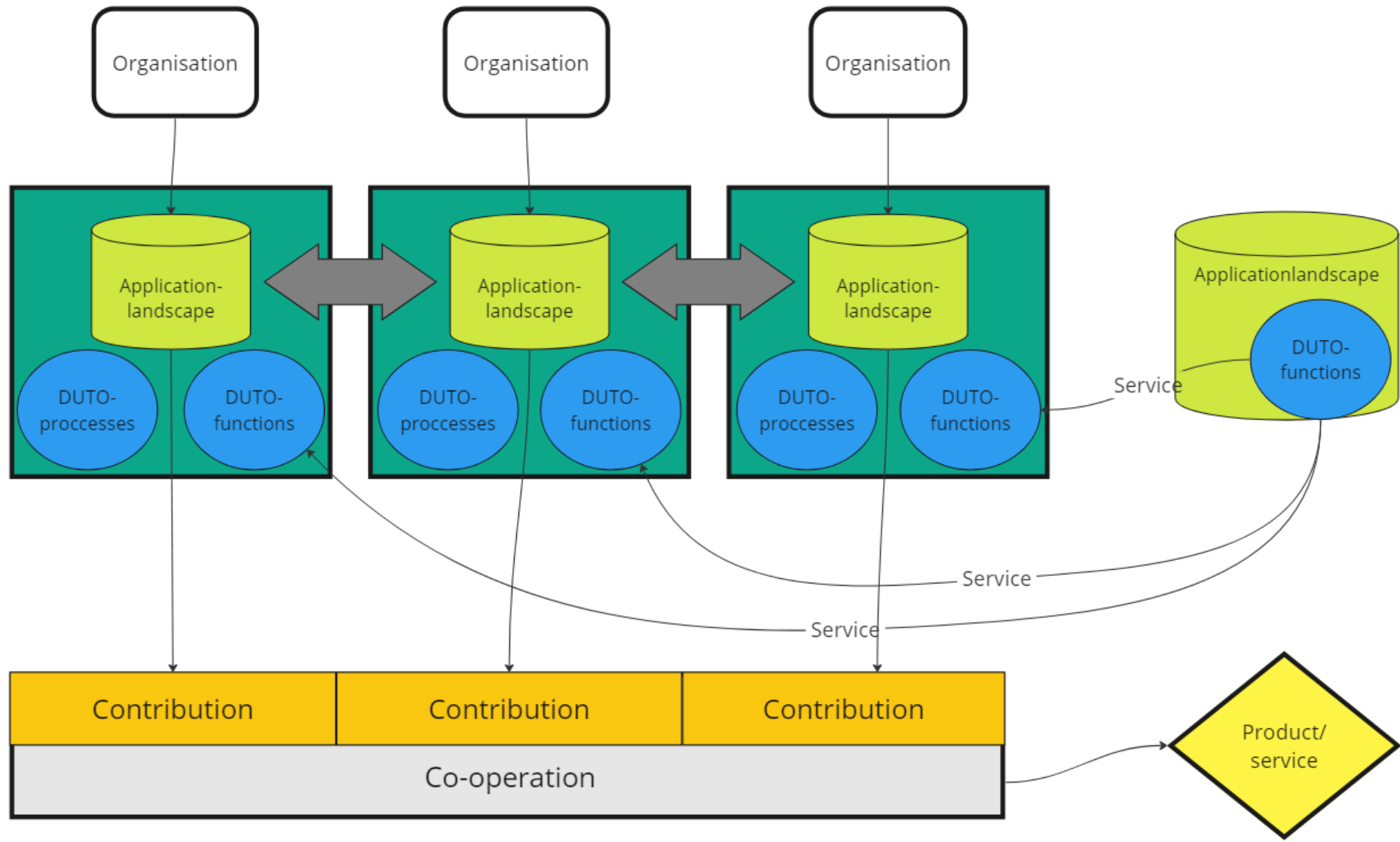

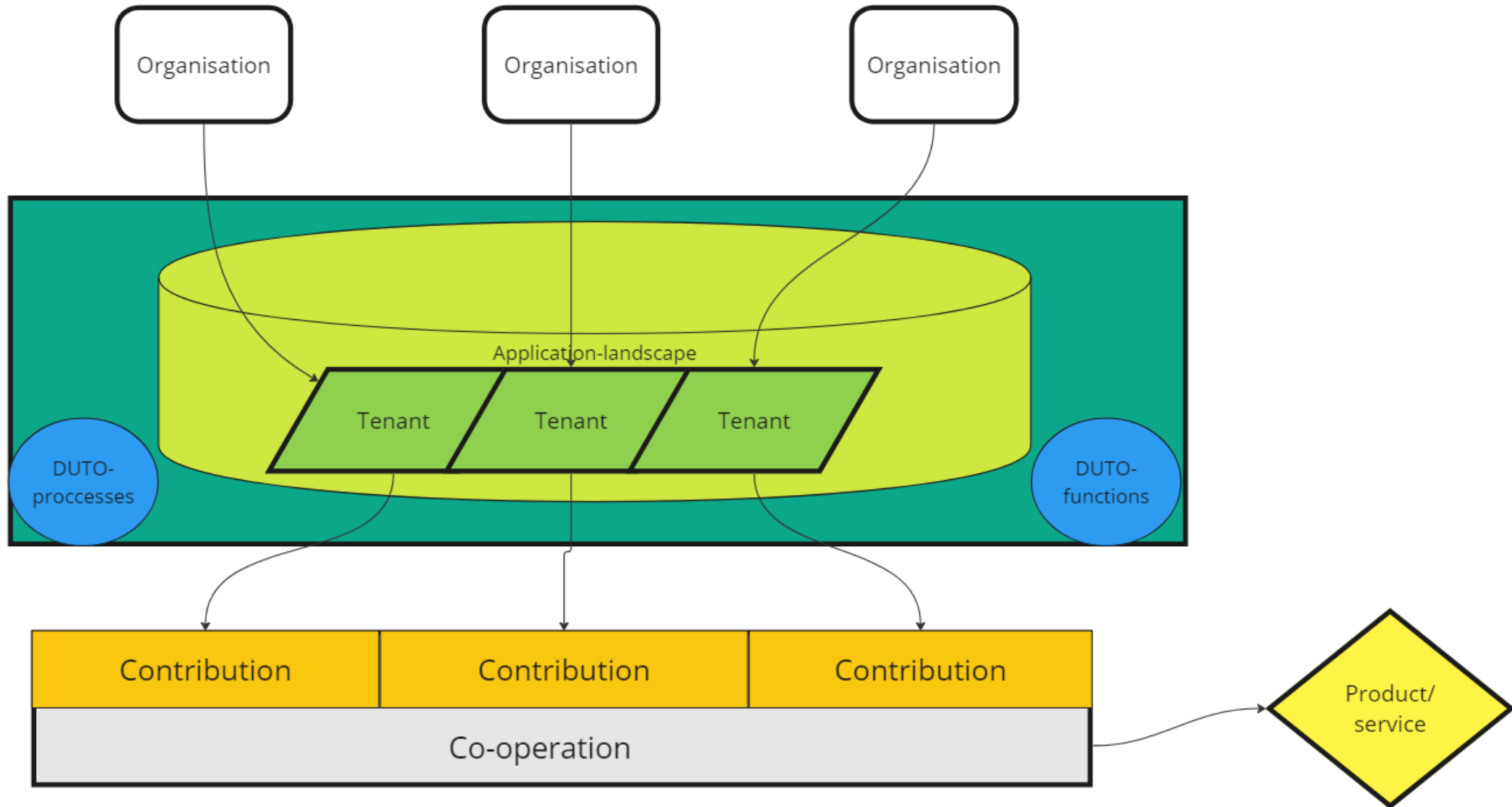
Option 1: Silo's
