

Milan Vojáček is a graduate of philosophy, history and archiving from the Faculty of Arts, Charles University. He has a doctorate in the social history of the 19th century from the Faculty of Electrical Engineering at the Czech Technical University in Prague.

He has worked at the National Archives of the Czech Republic since 2004, becoming the head of the department of records management inspection in 2014. Since 2015, he has led the National Digital Archives, which is an infrastructure ensuring the selection and long-term storage of digital archives for the entire network of public archives in the Czech Republic. Milan regularly participates in international conferences and workshops on digital archiving (IPRES, AUDES, DLM Forum,

NESTOR) and occasionally lectures at the Faculty of Arts, Charles University and the University of South Bohemia.
