

Stefan Kwasnitza is the deputy director of the Swiss Federal Archives (SFA). He has been working for the SFA since 2014. Previously, he spent five years at the Swiss National Library as head of the Library and Archives System team. He is a trained web programmer, has a degree in history from the University of Zurich and an executive Diploma in IT Business Management from the University of St. Gallen.

At SFA, he was the head of the Information Access Division until 2021 and developed the online-access, which includes the full range of services related to accessing the SFA and its digital documents. He was appointed deputy director in 2019.

In 2021, he became head of the Information Preservation Division. Together with his staff, he is responsible for the digital preservation system, the further development of the long-term digital archiving of databases (SIARD Suite) and the cooperation with E-ARK. He is currently leading various projects for the archiving of data.

Stefan Kwasnitza is Vice-President of the association of Swiss Archivists. He is also representing the SFA in the EAG subgroup 'Archiving by Design' and on the

executive board of the association Kitodo.org, an open-source software suite for the digitisation of cultural assets.
