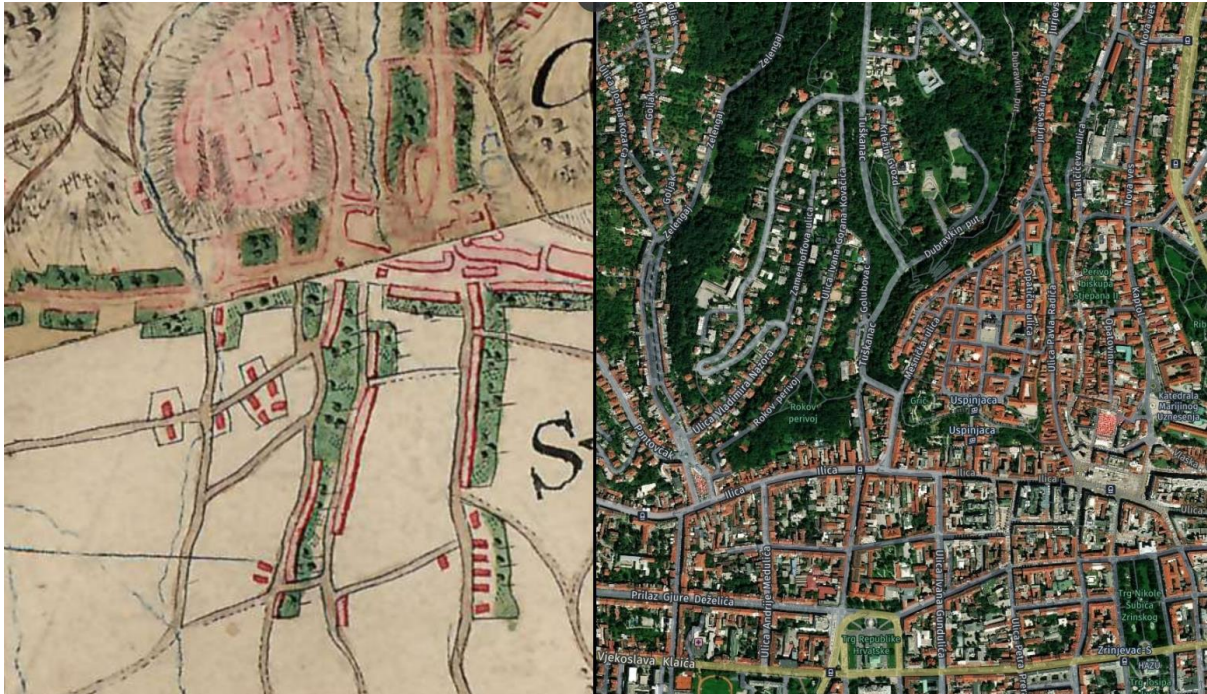


Geoforum Call for Papers

27-28th May 2020, Zagreb, Croatia



GEOSPATIAL DATA ENRICHING ARCHIVAL RECORDS

We founded the Geoforum on our DLM meeting in Helsinki, and we are planning our first Geoforum mini conference, parallel to the next DLM meeting, which will be held on 27-28 May in Zagreb. The conference itself will focus on artificial intelligence (AI), and we would like to add a geospatial aspect of it to the mix.

We are starting small, with just two 1,5h sessions, for which we invite you to present your current work or challenges in the field of geospatial preservation.

Possible topics for presentations include, but are not limited to:

- Current experiences with archiving and presenting information using digital maps
- Usage of digital geospatial data in combination with other (archival) records
- Role of digital preservation in the geospatial data Life Cycle

If you or your organization has something exciting to share, please feel free to suggest a paper even if it does not correspond to the one of the above-mentioned topics.

Submission

Please send an extended abstract of **no more than 800 words** and a short biography of the author(s) of no more than **100 words** (presenters only) in a single Word document to secretariat@dmlforum.eu by Friday 3 April 2020.

Applicants will be notified of the outcome in mid April.

Extended abstract

Extended abstracts are brief reports on current events or ongoing projects in one of the conference subject areas. The DLM Forum will schedule a maximum of 25 minutes for each presentation, which includes both lecture time and discussion.

General guidelines

The extended abstract shall be written in the font Arial (1.5 line spacing and 12-font size) and contain a maximum of 800 words. It should present (1) the scope of your work, (2) a brief description of the methods and approaches, and (3) provide an overview of your main findings and conclusions.
