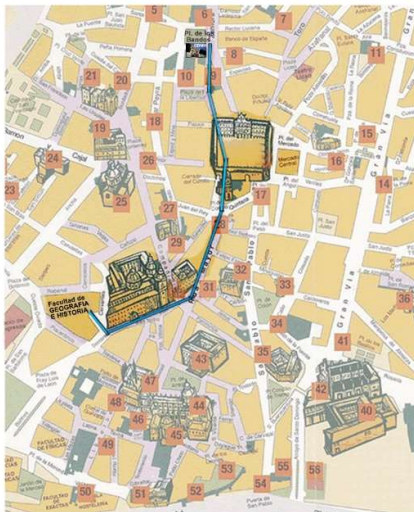


PRACTICAL INFORMATION

The main venue for the event will be the Faculty of Geography and History of the University of Salamanca (Facultad de Geografía e Historia de la Universidad de Salamanca), located at Calle Cervantes, s/n. 37002 Salamanca. Smaller group meetings will be held at the Memory Centre (Centro Documental de la Memoria Histórica), situated at Pl. de los Bandos 3, 37002 Salamanca, Spain.



COVID19 INFORMATION

There are no more COVID-19 restrictions in Spain. However, masks may still be required in hospitals, retirement homes, and other places.

REACHING SALAMANCA

The easiest and quickest way to arrive in Salamanca is by connecting via train or bus from Madrid. **Adolfo Suárez Madrid Barajas Airport** receives flights from all around the world, and connecting the airport with **Chamartín-Clara Campoamor train station** by train is quick (about 15 minutes, 3 stops). You can take two different commuter trains (**lines C1 and C10**, both of which stop at Chamartín) at Terminal 4 of the airport. If you arrive at a different terminal, there is a shuttle that connects the terminals.

There are two different types of trains connecting Madrid and Salamanca: **ALVIA**, which cover the distance between the two cities in approximately one and a half hours, and **regional trains**, which take around three hours for the same journey (<https://www.thetrainline.com/>, <https://rail.ninja/>).

Travelling by bus is also possible. There are **buses** available from the airport and from Madrid, and the journey takes around two and a half hours to cover the distance between the cities. Bookings are available at: <https://www.avanzabus.com/>.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT IN SALAMANCA

The historical city centre is small enough for walking, but there are various transportation options for getting around Salamanca:

- **Taxi:** The fastest mode of transportation. Taxi stands can be found near bus and train stations, Plaza Mayor, Gran Vía, Puerta de Zamora, Hospitals... The taxi company is **Radio Tele-Taxi** (telephone +34 923 25 00 00).
