Travel to Budapest

The most common ways to get to Budapest are by plane, train or by road by either car or bus - although you can even get a boat from Vienna and Bratislava. Budapest is relatively easy to get to since it's located right in the heart of Central Europe.

Taxi: The city rides don't have fixed tariffs, but their price is formed by a taximeter based on the distance and the traveling time. The flag fee is 1000HUF (2.90€/3.10\$), and the price per km is 400HUF (1.15€/1.25\$). Waiting time is also charged at 100HUF/minute (0.30€/0.35\$). The majority of the official Budapest taxis accept payments both in cash and via credit/debit cards. In any case, you should always carry some cash with you or inform your taxi driver if you are planning on using a bank card to avoid unwanted surprises. Payments are made in the local currency (forints).

Direct Trains to Budapest:

Budapest is a bridge between central Europe and the Balkan region. No surprise then that the Hungarian capital enjoys excellent international rail connections. There are a dozen direct trains each day from Vienna, seven from Prague, five from Munich, two from Zurich and one from Hamburg, Berlin and Dresden.



Plug/Socket types in Hungary

For Hungary there are two associated plug types, types C and F. Plug type C is the plug which has two round pins and plug type F is the plug which has two round pins with two earth clips on the side. Hungary operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz.
