PRACTICAL INFORMATION

The State Archives of Poland are pleased to host the DLM Forum Members' Meeting in Gdańsk. Gdańsk is a city on the Baltic coast of northern Poland. It is Poland's principal seaport and the country's fourth-largest metropolitan area. Gdańsk is a city with a unique history, which has had a significant impact on its contemporary landscape. For centuries, it has been a melting pot where diverse cultures, peoples, and traditions have formed a unique community.

Travel to Gdańsk:


Getting to Gdańsk should not cause problems. You can reach your destination by various means of transport: by plane, train, ferry, bus, or car.

> By train

For those who like to travel by train, we recommend the international connection Berlin — Gdańsk. Trains between the two cities run once a day, seven days a week. You can reach Gdańsk also by trains with a stop at the stations in Poznań or Szczecin. There is also a regular, direct rail connection between Gdańsk and Vienna.

Nearest train station – Gdańsk Główny station, only 9 min. walk from the City Culture Institute.

By plane

Nearest airport – Gdansk Lech Walesa Airport

Gdańsk Lech Wałęsa Airport has an extensive network of connections with airports in many European cities, served by airlines such as Lufthansa, SAS, Wizzair, Ryanair, Eurowings, airBaltic and Finnair. Connection map: <u>https://www.airport.gdansk.pl/flight-information/where-we-fly-p3.html</u>

From the Airport, there are several public transport options to the city centre.

The easiest way to get to *Gdańsk Główny* (the main train station) from the Airport is taking a PKM train (Pomeranian Metropolitan Railway, POLREGIO). The PKM connects to the SKM train (Fast Urban Railway), which assists in regional travel and getting from the Airport. You can change trains from PKM to SKM and vice versa at *Gdańsk Główny* and *Gdańsk Wrzeszcz* station. The train station (*Gdańsk Port Lotniczy* station) is located directly in front of the passenger terminal.

There are ticket machines on the platforms. Payment for tickets is possible in cash and with credit cards. You can also purchase tickets from the train manager.

SKM trains depart from platform 1 and 2 at *Gdańsk Wrzeszcz* station for the center of Gdańsk. On that note, the journey from the Airport to *Gdańsk Gł*ówny (via *Gdańsk Wrzeszcz*) takes around 45 min.

You can purchase SKM tickets via apps such as <u>jakdojade.pl</u> or in ticket machine located at the stations, or train manager (in the first wagon).

There is also a direct bus connection to the *Gdańsk Główny* with bus 210 from the Airport (runs twice an hour) or you can also take a taxi (we recommend Neptun Taxi).

Alternative flight options:

You can also land at the airport in Warsaw: **Warsaw Chopin Airport** (in the city) or **Warsaw Modlin Airport** (is an airport located in the town of Nowy Dwór Mazowiecki, approx. 40 km (25 miles) north of central Warsaw) and then take a direct train to Gdańsk from <u>Warsaw Central station</u> (*Warszawa Centralna* Train Station).

 From Warsaw Chopin Airport, you can travel by bus 175: you should get on at the bus stop: Lotnisko Chopina - Przyloty 02 (towards Pl. Piłsudskiego) and get off at the bus stop: Dworzec Centralny 01 or by train SKM: you should get on at the train station: Warszawa Lotnisko Chopina (towards Sulejówek Miłosna) and get off at the train station: Warszawa Śródmieście; ✓ From Warsaw Modlin Airport, you should get on at the bus ZL Modlin at the bus stop: Lotnisko Modlin and get off at the bus stop: Modlin. Then you should get on the train at the train station: RL93124/5Warszawa Lotnisko Chopina and get off at the train station: Warszawa Centralna.

By bus

Line buses are another popular means of transport in Poland. The line supporting the most connections is the FLIXBUS line. Contact: <u>https://www.flixbus.pl/</u>.

> By car

If you are travelling by car, we recommend choosing expressways and highways.

> By ferry

If you travel from **Sweden** – you can reach the port of Gdańsk six days a week, and daily in summer, from the Swedish Nynäshamm by picking the ferry POLFERIES. Detailed information is available at: <u>https://polferries.com/</u>.

You can also choose a ferry route from Karlskrona, served by the STENA LINE. However, this ferry sails to the port of Gdynia, a city located in the immediate vicinity of Gdańsk, from where you can easily reach Gdańsk by public buses and a city train.

Public transport in Gdańsk:

Tickets for buses and trams are the same. You can obtain them from ticket booths (rare) or vending machines. Payment for tickets is possible in cash and with credit cards.

After entering the bus/tram, you need to validate the ticket. You only need to do it once. It is also possible to buy tickets using apps (<u>Jakdojade</u>, <u>moBiLET</u>) but we recommend doing it before entering the vehicle. If you buy them via apps, you do not need to validate them, and they will appear in the app.

<u>Jakdojade</u> application allows you to check schedules, real-time departures, routes, maps, and buy tickets. It also works for transport in other cities.

There are **one-ride tickets**, that are only valid for one ride – after you leave the bus/tram you must buy another one to go further.

There are also **time tickets**, that allow you to change buses and trams until the ticket runs out of time (75 minutes, 24h and 72h).

Electric sockets in Poland:

For Poland, there are two associated plug types: C and E. Plug type C is the plug which has two round pins and plug type E is the plug which has two round pins and a hole for the socket's male earthing pin. Both types are suitable for the power load up to 16 A. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz.
