
Guidelines to apply eIDAS in a records management strategy

<u>The avoidance of sanctions</u> is a more powerful driver for the development of records management systems, tools and strategies than any other reason.

# eIDAS is a good excuse to <u>take advantage of standards</u> such as ISO 303001 and ISO 15489:2016.

<u>A regulation confirming the value of the electronic</u> signature and by extension the value of an electronic document is crucial for public institutions to support records management strategies. The Regulation offers the pillars for procurement contracts and specifications: assurance levels, audit procedures, traceability through metadata
